Stephen Ministry at FEPC

Stephen Ministry Myth #1

Myth: FEPC has enough Stephen Ministers (SMs) to meet the needs of our congregation and community.

Because each SM cares for only one Care Receiver at a time, we have sometimes had to put folks on a waiting list. A SM Training class is tentatively being planned for Fall of this year, so if you have ever thought of becoming a SM, or at least finding out more about the role you could fill as a SM, please be in touch with FEPC's Stephen Leaders: Amanda Trent, Karen Sutton, Marty Rodkey.
