#### **Getting Back to Worship**

As we begin our steps to reopening, these designated groups, at their discretion, are invited to attend, and the others will continue to worship at home via livestream:

Sunday, June 7— last name 'A-L' Sunday, June 14— last name 'M-Z'

Please keep the following in mind as you come to worship:

- ★ Use only the 3 entrances to the sanctuary
- ★ Masks and hand sanitizer will be available
- ★ Offering plates will be at the back of the sanctuary
- ★ There will be NO NURSERY
- ★ Only the 2 restrooms in the South end of Fellowship Hall will be open
- ★ At this time all other areas of the church are considered off limits

As you consider returning to worship, please adhere to the CDC guidelines and "Back on Track Indiana" recommendations as we gather:

- If you or a member in your household is feeling ill, please consider staying home.
- Those in the 'high risk' category should continue to consider utilizing our livestream service as opposed to attending in person.

Watch for additional guidelines to be announced for the remaining Sundays in June.

#### **Communion Observed**

Communion will be observed during worship on both June 7 and June 14, so that sanctuary worshippers with names A-L and M-Z may participate. Livestream worshippers follow instructions announced on May 31.

**Stephen Ministry Myth #4:** Handling SM Referrals is the Pastor's or the Referral Coordinator's Job

Reality: A successful Stephen Ministry referrals system in a congregation is a *team* effort. It involves the pastor, ministry leaders, and congregation members as well as the Stephen Leaders and Stephen Ministers. As you look around, please consider speaking to those you know or meet about the benefits of having a compassionate, caring listener through Stephen Ministry at FEPC. A successful SM referral system also involves people in the congregation - that may be YOU - being willing to accept a SM in a time of challenge or stress, or simply for a needed spiritual or emotional "tune-up." Your faith in believing that God can help you through a Stephen Minister is a sign of maturity. Accepting help can build up the whole body by allowing SMs to serve in their area of giftedness and help keep you spiritually healthy and growing.
