## Borrowing Policy

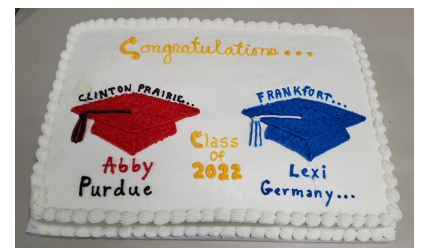

## Stephen Ministry at FEPC HELP, HOPE, HEALING Endure ...

*Stephen Ministers are not problem solvers or advice givers, but are trained to accompany those who are facing some crisis in life, for instance illness, death of a loved one, divorce, relocation, or financial setback.... Stephen Ministers are the caregivers; God is the Curegiver.* These words, written recently by a current FEPC Stephen Minister, mirror some from our first class of Stephen Ministers over ten years ago that I uncovered while sorting some files. I believe the principles of Stephen Ministry (SM) endure due to a firm reliance on Christ and His example of care. Because SM principles are biblical, they are timeless and always relevant. Situations may differ, but the care required and given is consistent. As another of our SMs recently put it: *How could such Christ-based care not result in Help, Hope, and/or Healing for the one receiving care?* Find out for yourself: when you need someone who'll listen without judgment or advice-giving, consider a Stephen Minister. 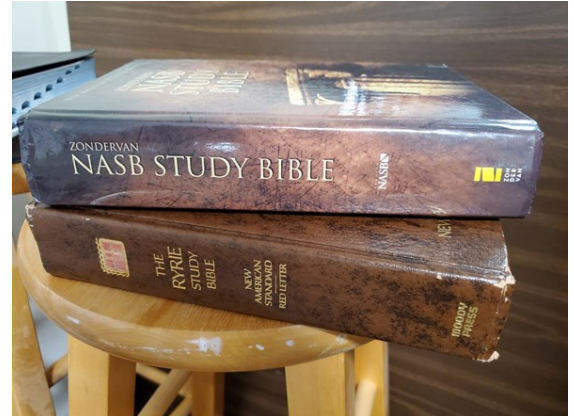
